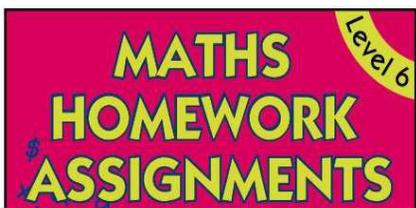

- Part-C is based on chart, you have to make any one chart out of the given topic.

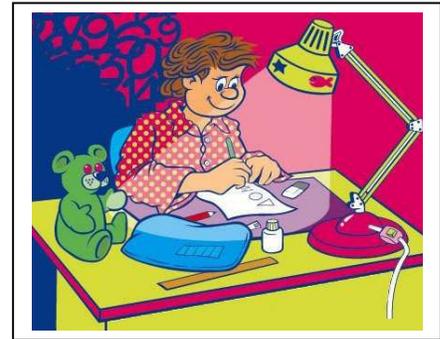

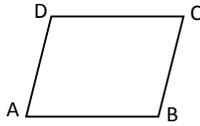
